Heritage Toronto volunteers make it possible to celebrate Toronto's heritage and build a compassionate city that honours its diverse stories.

We recognize those who have demonstrated exemplary service and commitment to the organization with the Volunteer Service Award.

- **One nomination** may be submitted by each active volunteer or member in good standing.
- Nomination forms must be completed in full and submitted **ONLINE** by the deadline: **July 28, 2017 at 5:00 pm.**

Submissions will be reviewed by a committee comprised of Heritage Toronto Board members and staff, with the award recipient approved by the Heritage Toronto Board.

ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS

- Volunteers must be currently active, defined as contributing to the work of Heritage Toronto between January 1 and December 31, 2016.
- Volunteers must have given at least five years of service to Heritage Toronto or made an exceptional contribution to the organization in a short period of time.
- Volunteers must have gone above and beyond the call of duty and provided exemplary service in their role.
- Paid services by volunteers are not eligible for consideration.
- Current Heritage Toronto Board members are not eligible for consideration.
- A volunteer may only receive the Volunteer Service Award once.



The Volunteer Service Award will be presented at the Heritage Toronto Awards on October 23, 2017.
